First Day of School:

Unfortunately, due to COVID-19, no parents will be allowed on the playground before or after school, including the first day of school. Supplies:

Labeling:

PLEASE label all of your child's belongings (coats, gloves, backpack, lunchbox, supplies, even shoes!) We will NOT have a lost and found this year, any items unlabeled will be thrown away if not immediately claimed.

Visitors/Lunch:

We will not be permitting visitors at any time, including lunch visits. Thank you again for your understanding.

Playground access:

Only students that are in attendance at Conrad Public Schools have access to the playground during the day. Students should not linger after school on the playground and must go directly home. Parents will not be allowed on playground during school hours

After School Program:

Our K-6 programs will tentatively start October 5th. Look for more details to come!

Breakfast:

- Breakfast will be served at students' individual buildings.

 served in Multipurpose Room
- Meadowlark School Ring in to Front door between 8:00 –
 8:20 served in Gymnasium
- We will ask for breakfast count for the following day each morning (i.e. Tuesday morning you would indicate Wednesday morning lunch).

Snack:

Snacks brought to school must be pre-portioned. No homemade snacks can be shared with classmates. We will also be participating in the Fresh Fruit and Vegetables Snack Program three days a week for grades K-6!

Walk to Math:

Walk to Math will continue at both Meadowlark and Utterback schools, following social-distancing protocols.

Inside Shoes:

Students should have inside shoes to be worn during inside PE and when in the classroom. They should be left at school throughout the year.

Water Bottles:

The school will provide water bottles or students may use their own, as all water fountains will be inaccessible. Students will bring home water bottles on Fridays and they should return to school on Monday clean. Students may also have their own personal water bottle if they prefer.

Face Coverings/Masks:

'Face Covering' is the language that is provided by the state for requirements, it includes gaiters, masks, face shields, etc. A face covering is like any school supply and the parents need to ensure their child comes to school with a clean face covering every day. Face coverings are also a part of the school dress code and must be school appropriate. Students will be able to take off masks when seated and in the classroom where 6ft of social distancing is observed, during physical activity, and while eating.

All students k-6 must arrive at school with a face covering worn properly. We are encouraging families to drop off children as close to the bell as possible, Utterback @ 8:20 Meadowlark @ 8:30
